**Purpose:**

Lead campus/program is a platform for the college youth which fosters entrepreneurial mindset and problem solving attitude through the innovative approach and creative thinking. LEAD activities like guest speaker's sessions, trainings, exposure visits, mentorships, workshops, initiation approach and exploring the opportunities will drive in inculcating or building leadership qualities among the youth.

**Deliverables by LEAD**

1. **Creating leadership skills and entrepreneurial mindset amongst the students through continuous mentorship and motivation.**

Orientation to the students about lead, workshops to the students for the motivation and initiation, mentorship to the students projects, team building activities for encouragement and support etc

The LEAD Team will design and deliver the modules on inculcating leadership and entrepreneurial learning among students and matching with the college schedule.



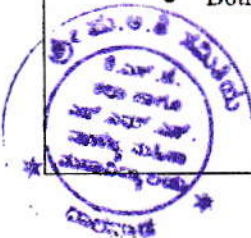


## **Deliverables by College**

- Both the parties will be mentioned in the media coverage.








