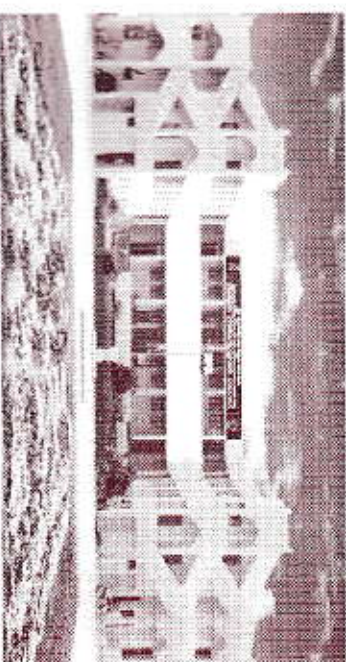

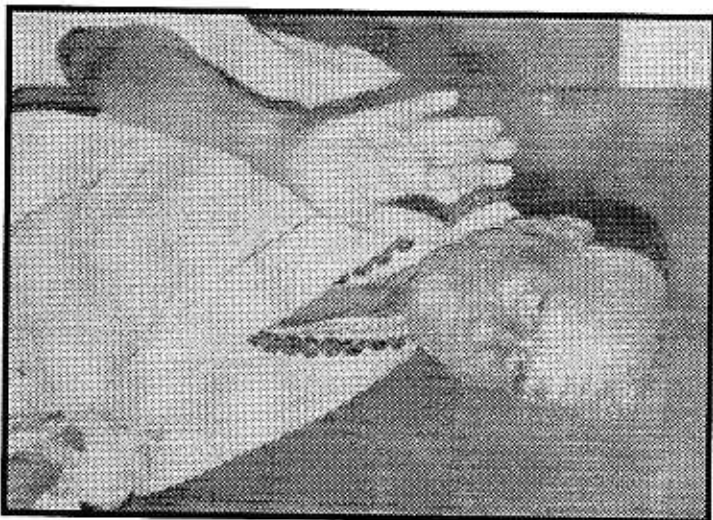

5 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

I) ATTENDANCE RULES :

According to the guidelines of Karnataka State Women's University, Bijapur, students must have a minimum of 75% attendance, to appear for the Annual Examinations. In case of shortage of attendance they will not be permitted to appear for the final examination.

II) GENERAL RULES :

1. If the student discontinues her study, she should inform immediately to the principal.
2. The students should get the receipt immediately after the payment of fees.
3. If the I.D. Card is lost, the student has to pay extra ₹ 5/- to get the duplicate card.
4. Uniform will be supplied in the college for prescribed amount.
Every Monday & Thursday, the student has to come in dress code-lest she will be fined.
5. N.S.S. volunteers have to render service of atleast 120 hours. B.A. & B.Com. students will have to pay fees for Unaided subject-In addition to the other fees.
7. **Fees once collected will not be refunded.**

Note : Students should complete their degree before six years after getting admission to first year degree.
