

Dr. Sadashiv Marji, deputy Director of food and civil supplies dept. said in his address that food is adulterated to increase the quantity and make more profit. Food adulteration is the process in which the quality of food is lowered either by the addition of inferior quality material or by extraction of valuable ingredient.

Various types of adulterants found in the food products are :

- Intentional adulterants; like coloring agents, starch, Pepper oil, injectable dyes and others
- Incidental adulterants; like pesticide residues, larvae in foods, droppings of rodents
- Metallic contaminants; like lead, arsenic, effluent from chemical industries etc

Some of the most common adulterated foods are milk and milk products, *atta*, edible oils, cereals, condiments, pulses, coffee, tea, baking powder, vinegar, *besan* and curry powder. Sometimes, simply looking at the food won't giveaway whether it's been adulterated or not.
