


## International Women's Day



A Workshop on the account of International Women's Day on **#BreaktheBias: A New Approach** was organized on 7th March, 2022 in association with Youth Red Cross Unit of our College. Smt. Dr. Ashvini Patil, convener, Progressive Women's Association carried out the programme, Smt. Shobha Sajjan, Convener, Youth Red Cross Unit Welcomed and introduced the guest.

There were two sessions. In session-I she dealt with the theme of this year i.e **#BreaktheBias: Towards Achieving Gender Equality**, where she gave good examples of silk industry and how women are achieving equal status as men through involving in silk manufacturing process. She briefly discussed about the process of how the mulberry cultivation takes place and how the raw silk will be extracted and transformed into beautiful fabric. 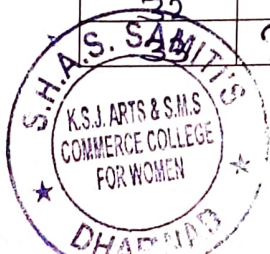
