

2.6.1 Programme outcomes, programme specific outcomes and course outcomes for all programmes offered by the institution.

The institution offers two programmes-Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Commerce. NEP 2020 has been implemented from the academic year 2021-22. Under new policy, students will be allowed to select two core subject and one elective from any faculty. NEP has proposed multiple entry and exit points for UG courses to provide flexibility to students and focus on skill development to improve employability. UG programme comprise of Discipline Specific Course, Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course, Skill Enhancement Course etc. Multidisciplinary curriculum under NEP includes Humanities, Sports and fitness, languages, Culture, arts and craft. The programme outcomes are achieved through curriculum that offers number of courses. Each course has specific outcomes. They are mentioned below.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (B. A.)

Programme Outcomes:

In the current Society the Arts stream is playing a very crucial role amongst student's career. The course gives the basic and advanced knowledge pertaining to the subjects they opt for and the compulsory papers for each semester gives the students the wider knowledge about the concepts. The BA Programme comprises of the popular optional subjects like Optional Kannada, History, Economics, Sociology and Political Science. It also includes the mandatory papers like Indian Constitution, Environmental Studies, Personality Development and Communication Skills. The students who want to take up the career like, Civil Services, Law, Teaching, Masters and Journalism opt for Arts stream and also fetch their career in various Government sectors. Most of our competitive exams, national and state level such as NET, SET, KPSC, UPSC, PDO, SDA, FDA, RRB, Postal, KSRTC, PSI etc are based on current events and are in the mode of multiple choice questions so students can be benefitted to acquire the knowledge and shape their careers by taking up this course. It is also helpful to take up entrance examination. B. A graduates can pursue B.Ed. course and opt teaching career. They can also do post graduate studies and pursue. M. Phil. or Ph.D. and take teaching career in Colleges.

Course Outcomes and Programme Specific Outcomes:

HISTORY :

The present concept of history and courses prescribed for undergraduates are designed to create a sense of the past, in a more comprehensive manner; history emphasizes on the study of culture during different time periods. It is very useful to study the historical events and also about the culture and civilization of our society at the regional, national. The course gives the wider information about the Indian History and Karnataka History and it also provides knowledge of historical events during ancient, medieval and modern periods. It is expected that a student who has taken up the history as an optional subject would be able to know their glorious past and is very useful for competitive exams.

At the end of the course students will be able to:

- Understand the political history of Karnataka and Cultural heritage of India
- Learn Indian History and culture - Gupta empire, achievements of Harshavardhana, Bahamani, Vijayanagar empire, Life and achievements of Jahangir, Shahjahan etc They will also have knowledge about protection of monument, Indian tourism act, Impact of tourism, etc
- Obtain knowledge of History of Karnataka, minor dynasties, freedom struggle in Karnataka, Unification movement in Karnataka etc.

SOCIOLOGY:

The course is helpful to know one's own society, its culture, institutions, and patterns of interactions among people. Whereas, the process of socialization is helpful to mould the personality. Knowledge about Indian society, Social problems, and Research methodology are helpful to the students and the field work following survey method enable the students to interact with people from other communities and elicit their views that in turn make the students aware of diverse social problems of people as well as address them through immediate or long term solutions. The knowledge about functioning of various social institutions in society and how it fabricates unequal realities for people the wider knowledge about the basic principles of sociology, theories of different social processes are very helpful to the students and specially those who take up competitive exams as it is one of the most scoring subjects in KAS. Students can fetch good jobs in social sectors and in community services; a civil service aspirant can opt for the subject.

At the end of the course students will be able to:

- Understand the nature and role of Sociology in a changing World and social institutions in India
- Sensitize the students to the conflicting norms of secularism and living by one's religious beliefs.
- Understand sociology of rural life in India
- The role of education and challenges in making the education accessible to all
- Obtain knowledge about research methodology.
- Understand social problems and urban sociology. This will develop the sociological insight among students and is necessary for constructing better future and reality for human world.

POLITICAL SCIENCE:

Political Science as a subject is very helpful for the students at the undergraduate level because it is the course with a significant thrust on Indian constitution, Indian politics and government, Public administration and International relations orients its students towards national and state level competitive examinations such as NET, SET, CSC, PSC, WBCS and IAS etc. Students can take up journalism as a popular career option. The course also provides the skill of public speaking among the students.

The course outcomes are:

- Understand the basic concepts in political science and nature and philosophy of political science.
- It is helpful to the students to understand schools of political thoughts and familiarize theory of western philosophy.
- Acquaint with the problems of Independent India
- Indian political thought and Political process in India.
- Expose students to Public administration, International relations.
- Develop knowledge of Indian administration and International organisation. Subject knowledge pertaining to the political issues across the world, gives insights about the political scenario and process.

ECONOMICS :

The subject economics is helpful to get preliminary idea of economic theories. It is also helpful to know about the economic variables including inflation, unemployment, poverty, gross domestic product, balance of payment using various statistical methods and software too. The subject also provides insights of Indian and world economy. The economics graduates can also shape their future in various central planning commissions, banking sectors and can be economic advisors to nation as well as to MNCs which have wider scope in the current society. Economics prepares students for career as professionals or researchers in the field of Economics. The students can fetch the degree and continue with the masters which have brighter future and can take up the competitive exams like IES.

At the end of the course students will be able to

- Understand the basic economic concepts and terms and operation of market system
- Understand the current problems of Indian economy and evaluate impact of LPG policies.
- Explain the policies and programmes undertaken by Govt. of Karnataka for bringing about socio-economic development.
- Obtain knowledge about the working of different types of banks, fluctuation in price levels and measurement same through index numbers, inflation and deflation etc.
- Understand changing trends in Indian economy & leading issues in India's economic development

ENGLISH :

It is helpful to enhance creative writing skills and critical thinking skills at the end of the course. Prepare students for the professional corporate as well as government job market. The course also provides knowledge about social networking, environmental issues, health issues, mass communication etc. On completion of the course the subject will increase self-confidence, prepare them for higher education, produce successful graduates, and develop research aptitude.

The course aims to:

- Helps the students to hone the LSRW skills and get equipped with knowledge of literary devices and genres.
- Introduce the students to modern women artist
- Phonetics, speech mechanism and organs of speech
- Develop knowledge in Letter writing, Paragraph writing, Travelogue writing etc.

KANNADA :

Studying the Kannada literature is helpful to understand the evolution of language through the ancient and the medieval ages and its present position has fully been described in the Kannada language and literature. This literature has given birth to a good number of drama and innumerable poems which are transformed into performing art in various forms in the current society. Students of Kannada literature can take up writing as their profession. Journalism is also another important profession which the students can take up.

At the end of the course students will be able to

- Understand impact of globalization on culture and human values
- Understand contributions of Kannada
- Enhance creative writing skills and critical thinking skills
- Acquaint the students with our culture
- Especially the syllabus designed by our university is pertaining to women empowerment and the novels, plays, dramas and poems are women oriented and the members have prescribed the literary works authored by the women writers and women issues being the central aspect of discussion.

Development Studies (OEC)

Graduates will be able to get a foundation of fundamental required to solve socioeconomic problems and also to pursue higher studies. Graduates will cultivate professional and ethical attitude, communication and team work skills.

BACHELOR OF COMMERCE (B. COM.)

Programme Outcomes:

The programme provides students with wide range of managerial skills and offers various career options. B. Com. degree is designed to enable the students to understand the various trends of business of the modern world. The programme covers diversified field of education. By end of the programme, student gain in-depth knowledge of core subjects like finance, accounting, marketing, taxation, statistics, business law, insurance, etc. After completing the degree, it becomes easy for the students to choose the right career of their choice. Com. graduate can start their business. It also prepares them for higher education. They can pursue MBA, ICWA, M. Com. etc. After PG they may pursue M. Phil. Ph.D. and join teaching as a career in Colleges or Universities.
